TRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION

Qualifications for the Best New Practitioner Research Project Grant

- Current member of the AST
- Current member of the AST Liver and Intestinal Community of Practice
- Trainee within first five (5) years after completing terminal training program who has
 demonstrated strong commitment to the field of liver transplantation. Current students,
 residents, and fellows are eligible (program may be residency, fellowship, or
 school). Gastroenterology fellows, transplant hepatology fellows, surgical residents, and
 abdominal transplant fellows are strongly encouraged to apply
- Research project must have been submitted and accepted for presentation (poster or platform) at the ATC 2019 meeting
- Grant applicant must be lead author of project

Judging of Grant

- Submissions accepted for ATC 2019 should be submitted via this <u>Travel Grant Application</u> by March 18, 2019.
- At least three (3) members of the LICOP Executive Committee will review and score each submission based on the following criteria:
 - Quality of research project (1 to 5)
 - o Impact of the research on current transplant practice (1 to 5)
 - Research significantly adds to the current body of literature on the given topic (1 to 5)
 - Up to three (3) travel grants may be awarded based on quality of the submissions

Expectations of Recipients

Recipients of this reimbursement travel grant are expected to attend the American Transplant Congress 2019 to present his or her work. Recipients of this travel grant are also expected to attend the LICOP Annual Meeting at ATC 2019.

Grant

One \$1,000 Travel Grant for ATC 2019 in Boston, MA (this is a reimbursement grant; you will receive the funds after ATC.)

Application Requirements for these Grants

- 1. Fill out the **Travel Grant Application**
- 2. Attach copies of your ATC abstract and ATC abstract acceptance letter

<u>Please Note</u>: Recipients of the ATC Young Investigator Award or a Travel Grant from another COP are not eligible for this grant.
