



Women's Health and Trainee and Young Faculty COPs Grant for ATC 2023

The American Transplant Congress (ATC) is the joint annual meeting of the <u>American Society of Transplantation (AST)</u> and <u>the American Society of Transplant Surgeons (ASTS)</u>. ATC provides a forum for the multidisciplinary exchange of new scientific and clinical information regarding organ transplantation. You can review the scientific program here.

The Women's Health Community of Practice (WHCOP) and Trainee and Young Faculty Community of Practice are introducing this grant to support interest in the next generation of medical professionals in a career in transplantation. Attending the ATC is a great opportunity for medical students and residents to learn more about the field of transplantation and connect with a community of trainees and mentors.

ATC 2023 will take place in San Diego, California from June 3rd through June 7th.

Qualifications:

o This grant is open to medical students and residents of all levels.

Applicants should provide the following:

- Application
 - Essay Question
 - Please describe your interest in organ transplantation and what you hope to gain from attending the American Transplant Congress (ATC) (1-2 paragraph)
 - o Curriculum vitae (CV) or resume
 - Letter of Support) from Faculty Member at Institution (OPTIONAL)
 - This letter should support your attendance at ATC and confirm that you are in good standing in your program. It should also state the dates you will be available to attend the meeting.

Expectations:

- Attend TYF COP and/or WHCOP annual meetings (dates will be released after the application period ends)
- Attend sessions at ATC
- Provide feedback on your experience after the meeting

What will this grant provide?

The grant is for reimbursable expenses up to **\$1,000** to attend ATC. Reimbursement expenses may include:

Registration to the ATC meeting

- Round-trip coach airfare
- Hotel/Lodging nights room and tax
- Meals while traveling (max \$50/day)
- Airport ground transfers (via shared van service, taxi, ride service, etc.)

Applications are due March 30th.
