All applicants must be AST members, be a member of the COP they would like to serve on, and have one of the two following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in a pre-doctoral or post-doctoral training program that is relevant to the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation
- OR
- Have completed their transplant training program within the past two years and are actively engaged in the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation (doctoral or non-doctoral).

### ADVANCED PRACTICE

All applicants must be AST members, be a member of the COP they would like to serve on, and have one of the two following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in a pre-doctoral or post-doctoral training program that is relevant to the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation
- OR
- Have completed their transplant training program within the past three years and are actively engaged as an APP in the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation (doctoral or non-doctoral).

### PEDIATRIC

All applicants must be AST members, be a member of the COP they would like to serve on, and have one of the two following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in a pre-doctoral or post-doctoral training program that is relevant to the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation
- OR
- Have completed their transplant training program within four years of completing fellowship and are actively engaged in the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation (doctoral or non-doctoral).

### PSYCHOSOCIAL

All applicants must be AST members, be a member of the COP they would like to serve on, and have one of the two following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in a pre-doctoral or post-doctoral training program that is relevant to the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation
- OR
- Have completed their transplant training program within the past three to five years and are actively engaged in the science and clinical practice of organ and tissue transplantation (doctoral or non-doctoral).
